# 3 · Christ-Centered

They should be able to freely pray in school, talk to their peers and teachers about God, and attend regular chapels. ## 4 · Safetv

A safe school is more than proper tornado and fire drills. When you drop your child off at school, you should feel comfortable knowing they are safe in every part of the building. Don't be afraid to ask guestions. Ask how the school handles emergency situations, transportation, check-in procedures, and COVID-19. Emotional safety is just as important as physical safety. Every adult should be on your child's team: available for help, ready to step in, and equipped to offer guidance. You should be able to trust your child's school to protect and love your child. A great school is safe and nurturing.

An excellent school is more than great test scores. A school that strives for excellence provides a well-rounded education, shows a sincere investment in your child, and is committed to providing lifelong lessons.
